School Supply and Individual Emergency Kit Lists

2022-2023

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

All West Sound Academy students must come to each class, every day, on time and prepared with the appropriate materials. Students will not have any storage area, locker or cubby while on campus. The goal is to maintain a reasonably packed backpack (rolling or otherwise) that has the basic supplies one would need while on campus. Students may be asked by individual teachers during the first week of school to provide additional items due to the needs of a specific class.

LEARNING COMMUNITY SUPPLIES – ALL GRADES

All students should bring the following supplies to the **Back-to-School night on August 23**. (This is an event on campus for parents and students, taking place from **5:30 to 6:30 p.m.**) The community supply materials will be stored in classrooms and will be available for use by all students.

- Two boxes (12-count *each*) pre-sharpened wooden pencils, #2 medium soft lead, with erasers
- Two pads Post-its® (3" x 3") notes - Please **do not get** Post-it® Super Sticky Notes as they leave an adhesive residue that damages books
- One package of glue sticks, 3-count to 6-count size
- One package of dry-erase markers, chisel-point, assorted colors, either 4 or 8 count
- Two boxes facial tissue, either flat or boutique box

INDIVIDUAL SUPPLIES – ALL GRADES

- Pens (black and blue ink)
- College-ruled, notebook filler paper, 8 1/2" x 11", 3-hole punched (approximately 4 packages of 100 to 150 count will last the whole year)
- Graph notebook filler paper, 8 1/2" x 11", 3-hole punched, for science and math
- 1 package Post-its® Tabs, 1 each in solid colors: Aqua, Yellow, Pink, Red, Green, Orange, 6/Color, 36/Dispenser – available [on Amazon](#) or at [OfficeDepot](#)
- Optional: you may prefer to have your own ruler, scissors, and set of colored pencils or pens
- Laptop or Chromebook with webcam - please contact Ms. Freeman at cfreeman@westsoundacademy.org with any questions regarding our Bring Your Own Device policy.
- Graphing calculator labeled with student's name (for Math and Science classes) - **Texas Instruments TI-84 Plus CE Color Graphing Calculator**. This calculator will be used by the student every year through graduation. *Note: Students who already own a TI-84 Plus or Silver edition do not need to purchase the CE color model. However, we strongly encourage families to purchase the CE model if their child does not already own a TI-84.*

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CLASS SUPPLIES – MIDDLE SCHOOL

- **6th-7th and 8th English:**
 - 2 composition books – non-spiral bound
- **8th Introduction to Spanish:**
 - 1 package ruled index cards, 3" x 5" or 4" x 6"
 - Dedicated section in their binder to hold college-ruled notebook filler paper for this class and to organize handouts and paper assignments
- **6th-7th Math and Earth Science:**
 - One dedicated folder for each of these classes
- **8th IES (Integrated Experimental Science):**
 - Dedicated folder or binder to hold college-ruled and graph notebook filler paper for this class and to organize handouts and paper assignments
- **8th Math:**
 - Dedicated folder or binder for keeping the college-ruled and graph notebook filler paper
- **8th Art and 6th-7th Design:**
 - Students in Art and Design classes are required to have one 8.5 x 11" hardbound sketchbook. If students prefer using a spiral-bound sketchbook that is acceptable.
- **6th-7th Movement:**
 - Students should bring comfortable athletic type shoes (sneakers; no open toe shoes, sandals or shoes with heels). Students should also own rain gear and a warm jacket for the colder months. All other materials will be supplied by the instructor.

CLASS SUPPLIES – UPPER SCHOOL

- **10th English:**
 - Designated Folder or section of their binder for handouts for this course
 - 3" x 5" lined index cards
- **9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th History:**
 - One subject-specific notebook to be left in classroom
 - One headset for listening and talking in the event that COVID requires social distancing, and for working with multimedia resources in class (e.g. [MASSOLIT](#))
- **9th-10th Emerging Spanish and IB Spanish HL/SL:**
 - 1 package ruled index cards, 3" x 5" or 4" x 6"
 - Dedicated section in their binder to hold college-ruled notebook filler paper for this class and to organize handouts and paper assignments
- **9th-10th Chemistry:**
 - One 1-inch 3-ring binder
- **IB Biology:**
 - A dedicated system to hold college-ruled and graph notebook filler paper for this class and to organize handouts and paper assignments

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- **9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th Math:**
 - Dedicated folder or binder for keeping the college-ruled and graph notebook filler paper for this class
- **10th Theatre:**
 - Designated Folder or section of their binder for handouts for this course
 - 3" x 5" lined index cards
- **IB Theatre HL/SL:**
 - **Theatre Journal**, available on Amazon: [Moleskine Classic Notebook, Soft Cover, XL \(7.5" x 10"\), Double Layout, Ruled/Plain, Black, 192 Pages](#) NOTE: Students can get any color of cover they wish, but they need to get *this size* of notebook and *this page style* - a combination of ruled and blank pages - for the work they will do in this course.
 - Designated Folder or section of their binder for IB Theatre handouts
 - One dedicated 16 GB USB flash drive
- **9th and 10th Art and 10th Design:**
 - Students in Art and Design classes are required to have one 8.5 x 11" hardbound sketchbook. If students prefer using a spiral-bound sketchbook that is acceptable.

INDIVIDUAL EMERGENCY KITS

In the event of an earthquake or other disaster during school hours, all students will be cared for on campus by West Sound Academy staff. In order to help everyone be prepared in the event of any such emergency, each student needs to have an individual kit with the following items. These kits will be stored on campus, and will be sent home at the end of the school year if they are not used. Use a plastic container about the size of a shoebox with a separate lid, and have the student's name clearly written on the outside. **Due to storage constraints at school, please use a container that is no larger than 12-quart capacity.** Please turn in emergency kits to the front office **no later than two weeks after the first day of school.**

Each individual emergency kit should contain:

- 2 large (33-gallon size) garbage bags
- 3 plastic spoons
- 2 granola bars
- 2 candy bars
- 3 containers of juice (aseptic cartons or cans)
- 1 Mylar blanket
- 3 cans of food (pull-top lid only – nothing requiring a can-opener)
- 2-3 small containers of pudding
- 3 packages of single-serve sandwich crackers (crackers with cheese or peanut butter)
- 1 flashlight with batteries
- Comforting letter from parents with photo
