Our Mission: to support students along an engaging educational journey where they can ignite their unique spark and learn to use it to make a positive impact in the world.



WSA is a private, independent school that strives to foster the unique abilities of every student who walks through our doors. We know that learning is a journey, not a formula to be followed. Rather than teaching students how to recite facts and adhere to formulaic standards of academic achievement, we strive to teach students to think critically and leverage their knowledge to excel in college and anywhere else life takes them next.

Our IB-based curriculum is designed to empower students to think critically, engage globally, and actively pursue their unique passions. The school offers a hands-on and creative curriculum, including Theatre, Music and the Arts.

Admissions

Students apply and are accepted based on a range of factors. We strive to admit students who are internationally minded and demonstrate intellectual curiosity. While we do not require an admissions test, the application process requires a student to visit and interview and submit letters of recommendation.

Calendar and Schedule

We have two semesters and a three-week term in June (June Term). During the semesters, students take seven classes – six academic and one elective. The schedule operates on a rotating block, with 90-minute class sessions. During June Term, students select one full-day or two half-day (180 minutes each) experiential learning courses.

International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme

We are an *International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme* school. All students in grades 11 and 12 are enrolled in IB classes. Students choose to submit materials to IB for consideration as an IB Diploma Candidate or Course Student. Theory of Knowledge is required for all 11th graders and also for 12th grade Diploma Candidates.

- In the class of 2023, 100% are submitting materials to IB with 90% submitting for the full IB diploma.

Grading

Due to the rigorous nature, small class size, and philosophy supporting the whole person, we do not rank students numerically. We report individual grade point averages.

- GPA calculation is **unweighted** on a 4.0 scale.
- Transcripts reflect IB courses by title.

COVID 19 – Online Learning

WSA provided synchronous online courses and operated on a Mod Schedule with the AY20-21 year divided into six 6-week terms and one 3-week June Term. Each Mod class is 0.333 credits. All academic courses met in three alternating Mods for a total of 1.0 credits. Mod course grades were averaged for a final year grade.

Community Demographics

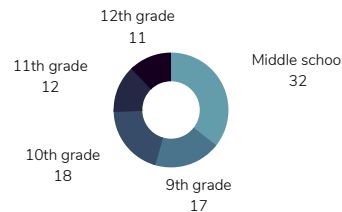
Located in Poulsbo, WA on the Kitsap Peninsula, across the Puget Sound from Seattle, our students come from Kitsap and Jefferson Counties,

- Setting is suburban, rural adjacent

Enrollment



Total enrollment: 90 students

Fifteen faculty instruct students in average class sizes of fifteen.

Our school community is more diverse than the North Kitsap region. We serve students who represent a range of backgrounds including, ethnic, international, linguistic, neurodiverse, gender non-conforming, and more. This spirit of inclusivity creates a caring and welcoming environment.

Since the first IB class in 2013, 75% of our candidates have earned the IB Diploma. The average score for those awarded the diploma is 31.

In May 2022 the highest IB diploma score awarded was 35.
